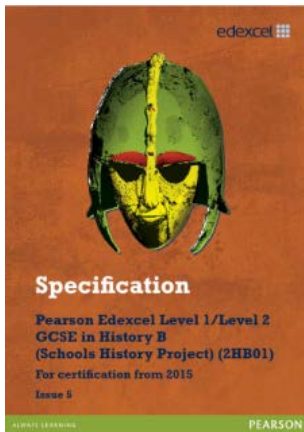


GCSE History – Helpful hints for revision.

You are studying Edexcel GCSE History B (Schools History Project) . You can find all of the information you need to know on the Edexcel website using the following link:

On the website you will find a copy of the specification and any past exam papers (scroll to the bottom of the page).

There are 3 separate Exams each worth 25% of your grade. You have already completed the controlled assessment; this is worth 25% of your grade.

Paper 1: Medicine and Public Health in Britain c50AD to present day. This exam is 1 hour and 15 minutes long. You will answer 5 questions and it is worth 53 marks (3 are SpG)

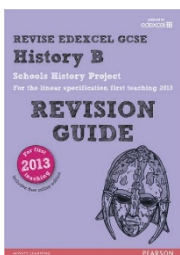
Paper 2: The American West c1835-1890. This exam is 1 hour and 15 minutes long. You will answer 5 questions and it is worth 54 marks (4 are SpG)

Paper 3: The transformation of surgery c1845–c1918. This exam is 1 hour and 15 minutes long. The question paper has six to eight sources and five questions and there are 53 marks available.

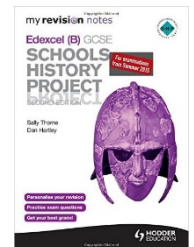
