EDUCATIONAL VISIT TO MUNICH & NUREMBERG

TNHA Humanities Department is delighted to inform you that it is in the process of planning an exciting **3-day** educational visit to **Munich and Nuremberg** in Germany, planned for **June 2020**. This is a wonderful opportunity for pupils to see first-hand the key sites associated with the creation and ultimate collapse of Weimar Germany. It will also provide students with a valuable insight into the subsequent rise of Hitler and the Nazi regime, all of which they cover on the Weimar and Nazi Germany, 1918-39 unit.

This will be a fully-guided tour and will support their studies in the classroom. The exam board that your child is taking, *Pearson Edexcel*, have endorsed it as an engaging and relevant addition to their Weimar and Nazi Germany topic bringing it alive for students in a way which a classroom lesson cannot. This experience will undoubtedly assist students in their efforts to achieve the best possible results in their GCSE History examinations.

To ascertain if it is viable, the Humanities Department would greatly appreciate it if you could express your interest in partaking in this trip by completing the form below as obviously, if numbers are not sufficient it will not proceed. The trip is open to all current Year 9 History students as they will be, by the time the visit occurs, in Year 10 and covering this exact material in their GCSE History classes.

The price of this trip is heavily numbers dependent and as such any costings provided are approximations but it will likely cost in the region of **£470 per student**, which will require a deposit of roughly **£150** initially with the remainder being paid over the following months prior to departure. Obviously the more that go, the cheaper it becomes and vice versa. Attached below is a draft itinerary which suggests the numerous sites students are likely to visit on this trip. This, like the price, is subject to change and is also numbers dependent.

Also included in that price will be:

- A private coach throughout.
- The service of an Anglia Tours guide.
- Return flights including taxes.
- Supplement of £10 per student/per leg for Ryanair to include 10kg hand luggage & seat.
- Hostel accommodation with multi-bedded rooms for students.
- Breakfasts, packed lunches and evening meals commencing with an evening meal on day 1 and ending with a packed lunch on the last day.
- All entrance fees associated with the visit.
- Insurance specifically designed for groups.
- A pre-tour presentation for students, staff and parents.
- A tour booklet for all participants.

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Items not included:

- Lunch on the first day and an evening meal on the last day as the group will be in transit. These meals will need to be paid for with students' spending money.
- Hold baggage (This should not be required on a 2 night/3 day trip of this nature).
- UK airport transfers (We aim to fund raise for this. However, if unsuccessful, students may incur a cost).
- Optional evening activities.
- Towels are not provided in hostel accommodation.
- Travel documentation including passports and visas, if necessary.

Next Steps:

As this is only a letter of enquiry, all the Humanities Department need you to do at this point is fill in the expression of interest slip attached and return it to **Dr Murphy** or **Mr Nash** by **Monday 15th July**. That will then give us a short time to correlate the numbers, contact the tour provider and obtain more accurate costings and a formal itinerary for the trip.

Please note the short turnaround period for the submission of the expression of interest form. Also, please do not express your interest if you do not fully intend following through with it as the prices and itinerary we obtain will be based on proposed numbers following the number of forms returned. Any amendments that then have to be made, due to students not paying the deposits, will only result in further price rises for those students undertaking the trip and could ultimately result in its cancellation.

It really would be lovely to make this trip a success as it would be a life-changing visit that will help your child to better understand the world, its past and provide them with a valuable insight into key elements of their GCSE History curriculum.
