What do Governors do?

As a Governor, you can help make sure our Academy is run well, pass on your knowledge and experience as you'll understand other parents' hopes and concerns.

Your work as a Governor can include:

- Monitoring the work of the Principal and Senior Team
- Reviewing policies and procedures, and making sure they are used correctly
- Representing the parents' view in all areas of the academy.

How do I become a Governor?

How much time does it take? As a Governor you would need to make time for:

- Preparing for and attending meetings
- Attend events such as concerts, open evenings, sports day etc.
