WHY DO WE HAVE A UNIFORM?

At The Nicholas Hamond Academy, we wish to maintain high standards, including those referring to clothing and appearance.

Our dress code emphasises smart and sensible appearance, which is appropriate for a school. The support of parents in helping students to meet our expectations is much appreciated. Trousers should be full length, skirts should be a practical length for the working environment either extremes of length are not suitable*. Shoes should have low heels (maximum 5 cm, recommended 3 cm), no steel capped/studded footwear, platforms or boots above the ankle.

We are sure that you will support us in insisting on the highest standards of smartness, cleanliness and pride in personal appearance. We expect our students to attend school wearing the correct dress and we reserve the right to send expect incorrectly dressed students to be withdrawn from social time such as break and lunchtime until their appearance is acceptable. If there is an emergency or problem with an item of clothing, we would ask you to send a note of explanation to the Form Tutor in the Student Planner.

JEWELLERY POLICY

Students with pierced ears may wear one plain stud in each ear; facial or body-piercing is not allowed for reasons of safety. School is not an appropriate place to wear an excessive amount of jewellery. Health & Safety requirements mean no jewellery may be worn in technology or P.E. lessons. For security and hygiene reasons staff are not permitted to look after these items during lessons; students should therefore leave these items at home on the days when they have these lessons. The school cannot accept responsibility for items of value lost under such circumstances. The following items are permitted, but must (for health and safety reasons) be removed during PE lessons and all practical lessons.

- A watch
- A ring
- A plain bracelet
- A necklace (chain and small pendant)
- A small stud earring in each ear (no hooped or drop earrings)
- No facial piercings are permitted



PLEASE NOTE

- Navy blazer with academy logo*
- Academy tie (worn long with small knot)*

- White shirt with top button – long or short sleeve
- Black plain leather or leather effect shoes (no boots, trainers, canvas or logos)
- Plain black or white socks



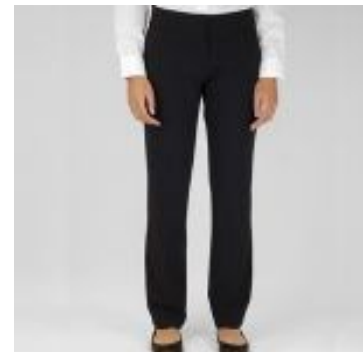

GIRLS' UNIFORM

- Navy blazer with academy logo*
- Navy academy jumper, with gold neck detail*
- Either, white revere collar blouse with college pin badge OR shirt with academy tie*
(worn long with small knot) - *college pin badges are available from the Academy (first pin badge is free of charge)*
- Plain black trousers of regular shape and formal design/fabric
(not tight fitting, stretch fabric or resembling jeans)
- Knee length skirt with logo*
- Black plain sensible shoes, leather or leather-look
(no boots, trainers, fur, canvas or logos)
- Plain black or white socks, black or flesh coloured tights

PE Kit Only

Shin pads should be worn when representing the academy in Football and Hockey fixtures and gum shields in Rugby and Hockey. These can also be used in lessons and are available to purchase via the Anglia Sportswear link. Students are expected to bring P.E. Kit to all P.E. Lessons. If a student is injured they are expected to produce a note from parents/carers. They will still be expected to change and take part in alternative roles such as official, coach and/or organiser. We accept that on occasions students may forget their P.E. kit. In this situation they are expected to borrow kit for the lesson from the P.E. Department.
