Year 10 Geography Fieldwork Investigation Tuesday 2nd July 2019

As part of the Year 10 Geography course students are required to complete a piece of primary data collection in preparation for their Fieldwork Exam. We would like to begin this study by taking the students to the Norfolk coastline, on Tuesday 2nd July 2019. This is an excellent opportunity for them to gain first-hand experience of data collection in the field.

Students will carry out primary data collection on several sections of the beach at Overstrand, during the morning, taking measurements on the coastline and will write-up their findings on their return to school. In the afternoon students will be working in small groups asking residents and tourists questions on coastal management, part of this will be unsupervised.

We ask that students be appropriately dressed for the day and bring waterproof/warm clothing if needed, wellington boots are essential as they may be required to take measurements in wet conditions. Students will be required to bring a packed lunch (this will be provided should a student usually have a free school meal). We will return in time for school buses if students normally use this route home.
