




Takeaway Homework

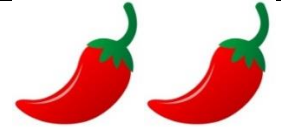
Menu

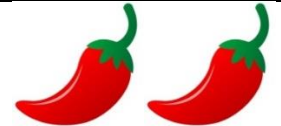
Starters:	
1. Choose 1 of the 10 most populated cities in the world and create 10 quiz questions about this city. Make sure that people can answer the questions by giving them multiple choice answers.	
2. Draw a copy of the settlement hierarchy onto a poster. Find a picture of each of the layers of the settlement hierarchy.	
3. Explain how and why population changes. Give examples of certain events in the past that have caused population to change. Try to determine which event in history has effected population change the most	

Main courses:

5. Explain what we mean by population? How has the population of the world changed? What impact does this have on people and resources? Which parts of the world are densely populated and which are sparsely populated? **Add in key words used in the lesson. Think about different countries and what their population is like. Pick several to talk about.**



6. Record a documentary outlining the reasons for poverty, both in the UK and around the world. **Write a script before you get someone to film you outlining what poverty is and where people are living in poverty**



7. Design a settlement (sketched or modelled). Think about what a settlement needs and how it can function. Think about the problems that will be created as population grows. Describe on a sheet of paper what your settlement shows and why you chose what you did. **Think about what makes a settlement schools, homes, jobs, open spaces, industry, transport etc.**

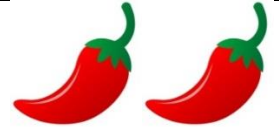

9. Draw a cartoon outlining some of problems of population growth in shanty towns/slums. Try to draw 3 different cartoons which demonstrate why life is difficult for people who live here.



10. Build a model of a shanty town/slum. Try to make it as realistic as possible with information about your chosen slum location (Dharavi, Favelas in Rio de Janeiro, Kibera) Describe what life would be like to live in your slum house/community



11. What is poverty? Think about the world and poverty? Why do we get poverty? Your job is to create a PowerPoint presentation on what poverty means, where it happens, and how it is overcome.
