


# Takeaway Homework

Choose your homework from the menu below.


The chilli rating suggests the difficulty or challenge the homework may offer. You need to complete 1 starter, 2 main courses and a dessert.

You should attempt at least one 'flaming hot' task!


<b>Starters:</b>	
1. Investigate ONE natural landform. Find a picture of it, locate it. Describe its main features. (For example, a famous mountain, desert, rock formation, etc.)	
2. Investigate one river from the start to the end. Print a map to show its route. List all the places it passes and all the landforms along it.	
3. Create a news report on a recent tectonic hazard (earthquake/volcano/tsunami). Your report can be written or a video or a blog	

## ***Main courses:***


4a. Make a 3D model of a river landform. Add labels to show the features. Explain how each feature was made.




4b. Make a 3D model of a volcano. Add labels to show the features. Explain how each feature was made.

6. Put together an emergency kit for a flood. Explain what you would need and WHY. Do one for a rich country and one for a poor country. How are they different? Why?




7. Explain why so many people live along the River Ganges in Bangladesh. Should they be moved away for their own safety? Why?
