
Choose your homework from the menu below.

Starters:	
1. Find a news story of a recent CONFLICT. Research the conflict and write down the key facts in your book. (What, When, Where, Why, How)	
2. Pick one African country, describing the population distribution of this country. Research some facts about the country and present as a poster.
